What is Solar Energy?


Sun emits a massive amount of energy. You can turn this heat and light into electricity using photovoltaic (PV) technology. All you need to start making your electricity through this method is a shadow-free roof area, solar panels, a solar inverter that converts this power and sends it to your home, and accessories (mounting structure, junction box, cables, etc.)

They together make a domestic rooftop solar plant that will generate power upto 25 years.

These PV systems can be of 3 types:

ON-Grid

ON-grid systems are connected to your utility grid (UPCL). If solar generation is low, you can pull energy from the grid to meet the demand. And, in case your plants generate extra power, you can send this energy to the grid and get paid for it. They only work when grid power (your regular electricity) is available.

OFF-Grid

OFF-grid systems don't need the utility grid. These are useful in places where power cuts are frequent. The OFF-grid inverter runs parallel with UPCL or as a backup during power failure. You need to attach a battery to these plants to use solar energy both during the day and night.








Hybrid

Hybrid systems are a mix of on-grid and off-grid. They can be connected to the utility grid and battery backup. Hybrid solar inverters remain switched on 24 x 7 (through out day). They not only run the home appliances but also charge the battery. In case of power failure, the battery backup provides electricity.

Cost of an On-Grid Solar Plant (With Net metering)

The total cost of your PV system will depend on factors like plant size, location, panel type, etc. A 1kW system is generally priced between ₹50,000-60,000.

However, a big part of this cost is paid by the central and state governments in the form of subsidy.

Subsidy available for Uttarakhand Residents

1. Central Financial Assistance

Incentive offered by the central government. CFA is slightly higher for hilly areas such as Uttarakhand.

Frequently Asked Questions

How much power can a solar plant generate?

A 1kW solar plant will ideally generate 4-5 units in a day, 135 units in a month, and around 1,620 units in a year.

What are the area requirements?

Approx. 90-130 sq. ft of roof area is required to set up 1kW solar capacity. This area should be shadow-free for maximum generation.

Are solar plants difficult to maintain?

No. Just clean your panels with water once every two weeks to clear away dirt and debris. You can also schedule a preventative check every six months to monitor system health.

4. What is the payback period?

You can recover your initial investment within 3-5 years (or sooner), depending upon the plant size, location, weather conditions, etc.

Will I still receive an electricity bill after going solar?

Unless you set up a fully off-grid solar power system, you'll still get an electricity bill. But it will be much lower than what you used to pay before.
